TOGETHER-IN-FAITH CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE THROUGH 9/30/2021

Nine months into 2021 we are very pleased to report the Together-in-Faith capital campaign is functioning as promised. We thank the St Martin's members who have contributed generously in 2020 and 2021, which allows the project managers to address the long-deferred care to our physical facility.

RECENT & PLANNED WORK: In September, a potable water leak of about 12 gallons per hour was fixed. The leak was under the concrete slab in the children's worship area and had likely been flowing for years. The leaking line was capped off and new lines run above the ceiling. This repair will not only save dollars for purchased water but should also avert future moisture problems and helps us be good stewards of our resources.

The category of "Safety & Security" is the current focus for Capital Outlay. Our 30-year-old Fire Monitor Panel can no longer be repaired if a component fails because the parts are no longer available new or used. This panel receives signals from smoke sensors in each room, temperature sensors in kitchen areas, and from the "fire-pull" stations all around the facility. Our fire monitoring company receives alarms and alerts the fire department when required. We are now requesting quotes for replacement of the monitor panel.

The purpose is to keep our House of Worship, our Parish Hall, and our other facility space fully usable in the support of the mission and ministries of our parish for our members and community.

CAMPAIGN FUND CONTROLS: Campaign funds are held in a Special Purposes Account, and not be used for items described in the annual operations budget. Vestry Executive Committee unanimous approval is required before spending occurs and for an amount above \$5000, Vestry approval is required.
