

Sunday School (Children's Church) annual 2025

Children's Worship is continuing to work on building our Sunday school attendance and volunteers. Children's Church meets during the 10:30 a.m. Sunday morning service and the children re-join their families for communion. Children's Church is divided into prayers, lessons, snack, and crafts. Denise Marsh joins us to teach the children songs and bells.

The curriculum is based on the Virginia Seminary on-line program. It is a 3-year rotating program. The first half of the year is devoted to stories of the Old Testament. The second half of the year is devoted to the New Testament and the history the church.

We sponsor Breakfast with St. Nick in December and Breakfast with the Bunny a week before Easter. The Men's Club partners with us by setting up Park Hall, cooking, serving breakfast, and cleaning up the kitchen. In addition to breakfast, the children get a special visit from St. Nicholas and the Easter Bunny and craft activities are provided. Both events are free of charge for the families and we welcome children of all ages to attend.

Children's Church runs from September through May. However, in the summer we also offer Vacation Bible School for the children in our parish and community. By participating in the Children's Worship program, the youngest members of our parish community are making personal connections with children within in their church family while learning about our church history and instilling the love of God.
